



MICRONEEDLING WITH PRP

We are exciting to introduce **Microneedling with PRP** to Charlottesville Dermatology. This treatment is a great way to rejuvenate the skin painlessly. Microneedling on its own works well to brighten and refresh the skin, heal acne scars, and promote collagen production to fill in wrinkles. The addition of PRP, or platelet-rich-plasma, takes the treatment to the **NEXT LEVEL**.



What is PRP?

PRP, or platelet-rich plasma, has been in use for years to help speed recovery from sports injuries by encouraging the growth of new tissue. By adding PRP to a microneedling treatment, we encourage collagen production. Aging skin becomes tighter and smoother, acne scars can be reduced, and skin becomes brighter and more youthful. This treatment is also beneficial for stimulating hair restoration.

PRP is created using the patient's own blood, so there is no risk of an allergic or adverse reaction. A small vial of blood is drawn, then a centrifuge is used to separate the red blood cells from the platelets. The platelet-rich plasma is then refined, injected, and used on the skin.



What is Microneedling?

Microneedling involves multiple tiny needles creating channels in the skin. This stimulates the skin's natural healing abilities and collagen production. It is a good treatment for non-invasively reducing fine lines and wrinkles, fading dark spots, smoothing acne scars, and reducing stretch marks, among other uses.

Microneedling is great for men and women looking for subtle, gradual rejuvenation. Side effects of microneedling may include redness or swelling, but these effects generally subside within three days. For some people, they fade within 24 hours.

What are *Strawberry Hemangiomas, Angel Kisses* and *Stork Bites*?

All of these refer to different types of pink or red birthmarks in children. These vascular birthmarks are formed when extra blood vessels clump together in the skin.


Some vascular birthmarks such as angel's kisses may go away on their own, while some may stay with a child for a lifetime. While

most vascular birthmarks do not hurt a child, there are some that can need more evaluation, especially if located on the face, if large, or if there are many of them.

A pediatric dermatologist evaluates vascular birthmarks to see if they need treatment. In addition, a pediatric dermatologist can also tell you if there are options to lighten the vascular birthmark, such as with laser, surgery, or makeup.
